Travel Information

Meet at Quivira campus church at 8:30 am on Tuesday, June 13

- In Class A Scout Uniform
- Turn in Lock Combination or Extra Key to Camp Scoutmaster
- Bank check-in (for your son's money)
- All prescription and non-prescription medicine needs to be checked-in
 - All meds in the original prescription container, unless it's over-the-counter
- Camp Box Inspection
- Head count verification

Leave at 9:30 am

We will stop in Clinton, MO for lunch at one of the several fast food restaurants. Make sure your son has separate money for lunch. (Do not turn it all in at the bank check-in)

Return around noon at the church on Thursday, June 22

When you get home, unpack everything in the garage or outside. (Keep insect hitchhikers out of the house.)

Visitor Sunday, June 18

Family is invited to spend the day with us at camp. Camp opens to visitors at 10:00 am and ends at 5:00 pm. Lunch is a pot luck. The troop will provide protein for lunch. Families will bring side dishes or desserts to share. Wear closed toed shoes, not sandals. Bring chairs, hats, and sunscreen. We will email more detailed information when we get closer.

Schedule at camp

- Daily Schedule – (talk about KP)
- Week Schedule – Ceremony Schedule (Tribesman and registered campers only)
- Visitors Sunday – no registration necessary
- Part Time Adult Leader Arrival
 - Each adult must check-in at the Health Lodge. Do not go to the Sawmill camp office.
 - They will give you a check-in form so the Camp Piercing Arrow office can check you in.
 - Leader wristbands will be used for all Scouters in camp.
 - We will turn in your current Medical Form and it will be on file at the Health Lodge for your check-in.

Only Registered Adults are allowed in camp. Only exception is Visitors' Sunday.

If you have to pick your child up for a family emergency or any other reason, they must be checked out with our Troop Camp Scoutmaster Scott Scogland at the Osage River Trading Post (Camp Office). Boys are the responsibility of the Troop in camp.
